

## USING EXAMVIEW AND ANGEL FOR TESTS

This is assuming you have installed ExamView from the CD that came with your textbook.

1. Double click the ExamView Generator on your Desktop.
2. Click on “Open an Existing Question Bank” (if you want to use questions later on final).
3. Click on the bank to which you want to add your question.
4. Click on Question, New, Choose the Type.
5. Type the question.
6. Type the answer in the lower right corner.
7. Click on Record.
8. Create as many questions as you want.
9. Save (two separate places would be good).
10. Click on File, Switch to Test Builder
11. Click on “Create a New Test From Scratch.”
12. Name the test and click on OK on the Information Window.
13. Click on the “Select While Viewing” button (binoculars).
14. Pick a bank or banks you want to use including any banks you created.
15. Click on Next.
16. Select questions you want to use – it is best to use true/false, matching, multiple choice.
17. Save.
18. Click on File, Publish to, Angel.
19. If not set up already...click add new server. Skip to step 23 if already set up.
20. Type in a profile name of your choosing.
21. Type in the URL <http://evsc.angellearning.com>
22. It should prompt you for your username and password for Angel.
23. Click on OK on the first “Publish to Angel” window.
24. Pick a class on the next “Publish to” window and click ok.
25. If you have folders in your Lessons tab make sure you select the appropriate folder.
26. Go to Angel, the class, and rearrange to the top of the list, save (the test should already be there).
27. Click on Access tab, Advanced, set restrictions.
28. Click on Interaction tab and make any other settings.
